I played volleyball at perennial GCL powerhouse Mount Notre Dame High School in Cincinnati and at Thomas More College. My Junior year at TMC, I broke two school records for attempts and total kills. I was also named to the KWIC All Conference Team and the Marietta College All Tournament Team. My senior year at TMC, I was a team captain and the team had the best record in school history going 42-7 and making it to the NCAA Division III Sweet Sixteen.

I have been coaching volleyball for 21 years. I started coaching 8th grade volleyball at St. Susanna School in Mason, Ohio while I was playing at Mount Notre Dame. From there I went on to coach for Blue Chip Volleyball club in Cincinnati. I have been with NKJV since 1995 and have coached at numerous age levels and served as club director for the last 9 years.

I have coached high school volleyball for 13 years. I was at Ryle and Bishop Brossart High School for 3 years, Campbell County for 1 year and Conner for 4 years. I was also an assistant at Ludlow for two years prior to getting my teaching degree.
